Families will receive vouchers to deliver to each customer who purchases rolls along with any gift cards ordered. Customers take the vouchers to pick up their frozen rolls at Texas Roadhouse in Bridgeville from November 25<sup>th</sup> to the 27<sup>st</sup> which has baking instructions marked on each dozen. It’s that easy!

- rolls for \$5.00 a dozen and earn \$2.50
- cinnamon butter for \$4.00 a pint and earn \$2.00
- \$10.00 Texas Roadhouse Gift Cards and earn \$1.00
